Type of Work Involved: Volunteers are needed to serve as observers and live scorers. The instructions of each job are listed below. (There will be a volunteer meeting prior to the event, about a week before the event. At the meeting, we will review the event, talk about the roles, give tee time assignments, etc.)

1. Observer Instructions (6-7 Hour Time Frame)

- Observers will assist the rules committee in deciding questions of fact and to report to the rules committee any breach of a playing rule.
- To assist with pace of play, encourage the kids to help other kids look for their golf balls if they are lost, but try to make sure that they are ready to play when it is their turn.
- Observers are not rules officials.
- Observers should check with all players after every hole to verify scores.
- Observers must stay with the assigned group for the entire round and can observe a group with a participant from their school.

Max Number of volunteers needed: 40

2. Live Scorer Instructions (2-3 Hour Time Frame)

We will be reporting scores every three holes so they may be posted on the internet for distant family and friends to keep in touch as well as on the Clubhouse TV for onsite guests to keep track.

- Live Scoring Volunteers will be situated near the greens of holes.
- Record the time each group completes putting and places the flagstick back into the hole.
- Record scores provided by the Players for the previous three holes.
